

INSTRUMENT OF DELEGATION

CIVIL AVIATION ACT 1990 AND CIVIL AVIATION RULES

In accordance with section 23B(2) of the Civil Aviation Act 1990, and acting with the written consent of the Chief Executive of the Ministry of Transport (acting under delegation from the Minister of Transport), given on the 11^{h_1} day of August 2016

HEREBY DELEGATE to

EVAN KAYE LAMBERTON CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

NEW ZEALAND HANG GLIDING AND PARAGLIDING ASSOCIATION

ALL THE FUNCTIONS AND POWERS that may be exercised by the Director of Civil Aviation under the Civil Aviation Act 1990:

- 1. section 8, to receive applications for hang glider pilot certificates; and
- section 10, to determine whether or not a person is fit and proper to hold a hang glider pilot certificate, or that a current holder of such a certificate continues to satisfy the fit and proper test, including to seek and receive such information (including medical reports) as EVAN KAYE LAMBERTON thinks fit; and consider information obtained from any source; and
- 3. section 9, to grant or renew hang glider pilot certificates as required by Civil Aviation Rules Part 106; and
- 4. section 7(3), subject to any civil aviation rules, to issue hang glider pilot certificates for such specified periods and subject to such conditions as **EVAN KAYE LAMBERTON** considers appropriate in each case.
